

Tourism Board minutes
October 24, 2016

The Rock Port Tourism Board met Monday, October 24, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. at Rock Port City Hall. Members present were Denton Melvin, Candy Jennings, Donnie Parsons, Chris Shimmel, and Tami Lansdown. Also present was City Clerk Ashtin Paris.

The meeting was called to order.

Additional quilt stands will need to be made for this year. Materials will be purchased from Burke and Sons Lumber to make the stands. Food will be provided by Holy Smokes BBQ and the Enchilada Lady. The Me Market will be held Saturday, November 5th from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. The Quilt Show will be held Saturday, November 5th from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and Sunday, November 6th from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. The Quilt Show & Me Market will be held at the Rock Port High School.
